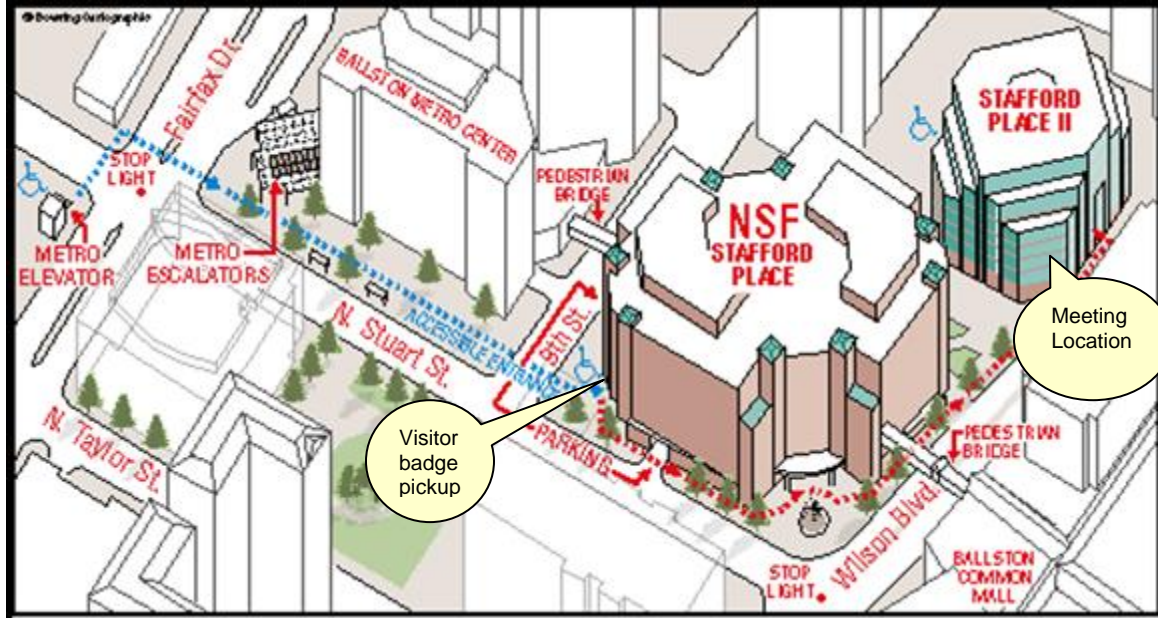


Directions and Procedures for coming to Meetings within the National Science Foundation (NSF)



The Ontology Summit 2016 Symposium will be held in Stafford Place II, in room 555, 5th floor. Stafford Place II is next to the National Science Foundation (NSF) at 4201 Wilson Boulevard (Stafford Place), Arlington, VA 22230.

Before coming to the meeting space in Stafford II, you must first obtain a visitor's badge at the NSF Information and Conference Center Desk. It is located on the first floor of Stafford Place at the North Stuart and 9th Streets entrance. Once you have obtained your visitor's badge, please proceed to the NCO offices or meeting space in Stafford Place II. (See the red dotted line on the map above).

If you are traveling by Metro, take the Orange line to Vienna (Virginia) and get off at the Ballston-MU stop. Upon exiting Metro, proceed south on N. Stuart Street to the NSF entrance at the corner of N. Stuart and 9th Streets to pick up your badge. (See the blue dotted line on the map above).

If you are traveling by car, see Google maps (<http://maps.google.com/>) to obtain directions from your location using 4201 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, Virginia 22230 as the destination address.

Garage parking is available at 4121 Wilson Blvd. Arlington, VA 22230 for \$6.50 (before 10am), 9th Street, and N. Stuart Street parking garages for \$9.00 per day. Metered parking is available on the surrounding streets.
